Job purpose

Duties and responsibilities

The Interior Designer oversees all Design Finishes and Furnishings for Brighton Projects, which includes collaborating on Project Coordination. The Designer will meet with new homeowners to determine the design from conceptual development to executing the design. This role visualizes client goals, sources products and materials and determines costs.
